IN RE: SB750 by Birdwell (Relating to restrictions on holders of package store permits.), As Engrossed

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code relating to restrictions on holders of package store permits, by repealing Sections 22.04 and 22.05. The Alcoholic Beverage Commission has determined that the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact to the State. The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
