IN RE: SB848 by Huffines (Relating to the licensing and regulation of providers of driver and traffic safety education.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the licensing and regulation of providers of driver and traffic safety education.

The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation and the Department of Public Safety indicate they could absorb the costs associated with the bill within their current resources.
