IN RE: SB1024 by Nelson (Relating to the use of certain lighting equipment on airport security vehicles.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code relating to the designation of an authorized emergency vehicle. The bill would allow an emergency management or airport security vehicle to be equipped with flashing blue and amber lights if the vehicle is owned or leased and has been designated or authorized by the joint board.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

Local Government Impact
