**IN RE: SB1168** by Uresti (Relating to the disqualification of directors of the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Special District and Local Laws Code relating to the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District. The bill would allow the board by a unanimous vote of the remaining directors to remove a director who has missed one-half or more of the regular meetings scheduled during the prior 12 months.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.
