IN RE: SB1382 by Hughes (Relating to the use of local government energy savings performance contracts for measures that avoid expected future operating or maintenance costs.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to include in the definition of energy savings an estimated amount of avoided expected future operating and maintenance costs. According to the Texas Municipal League and the City of Marshall, no fiscal impact is anticipated.
