### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Insurance Code relating to the premium surcharge certain automobile insurers are required to assess against an insured convicted of certain offenses. Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance, this analysis assumes the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
