**IN RE:** SB1495 by Zaffirini (Relating to access by the division of workers' compensation to certain designated doctor contracts under the workers' compensation system.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Labor Code relating to access by the division of workers' compensation to certain designated doctor contracts under the workers' compensation system. Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance, this analysis assumes the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
