**IN RE:** **SB2006** by Watson (Relating to erecting or maintaining certain outdoor signs regulated by the Texas Department of Transportation.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend provisions of Chapters 391 and 394 of the Transportation Code relating to the regulation of certain outdoor signs by the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) or a municipality.

Based on the information provide by TxDOT, it is assumed implementation of the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact to the state.

**Local Government Impact**

According to the Texas Municipal League, the fiscal impact to municipalities to implement the provisions of the bill is not anticipated to be significant.
