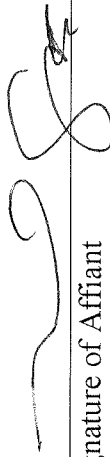

NOTICE

This is to give notice of intent to introduce in the 85th Legislature, Regular Session, a bill to be entitled an Act relating to the Frio Hospital District. Such bill shall authorize the Board of Directors of the Frio Hospital District to order an election regarding the expansion of the District's boundaries following receipt of a petition signed by at least 50 registered voters of the territory to be annexed or a majority of those voters, whichever is less. Annexation of territory shall require approval of a majority of the voters at an election held in the District and by a majority of the voters at a separate election held in the territory to be annexed.
