HB 281 Howard | et al.  
Relating to establishing a statewide electronic tracking system for evidence collection kits used to collect and preserve evidence of a sex offense.

HB 383 Murphy  
Relating to enhancing the penalties for certain repeat and habitual offenders.

HB 401 Villalba  
Relating to civil or criminal liability for leaving certain animals unattended in or removing certain individuals or animals from a motor vehicle.

HB 491 Frullo  
Relating to requiring registration as a sex offender of certain defendants convicted of the offense of continuous trafficking of persons.

HB 667 Canales  
Relating to prohibiting a person's waiver of a right to an expunction or to an order of nondisclosure of criminal history record information with respect to a criminal offense.

HB 681 Wu  
Relating to restricting access to certain information that relates to a person convicted of or granted a dismissal after deferral of disposition for a fine-only misdemeanor offense.
