Relating to the punishment for the offense of tampering with a governmental record; increasing a criminal penalty.

Relating to political contributions by corporations and labor organizations to certain political committees.

Relating to permitting the Texas Ethics Commission to provide seminars and charge an attendance fee for those seminars.

HB 2471 Davis, Sarah
Relating to prohibiting political contributions and political expenditures made by certain persons with public funds; creating a criminal offense.

HB 2473 Davis, Sarah
Relating to the disclosure by vendors of gifts to certain local government officers and of certain relationships with local government officers; creating an offense.

HB 2523 Davis, Sarah | et al.
Relating to the investigation of fraud, waste, and abuse in certain public benefits programs by the office of inspector general for the Health and Human Services Commission.

HB 3305 Larson
Relating to the eligibility for appointment to public office by the governor of persons who make certain contributions.

HB 3489 Muñoz, Jr.
Relating to audits conducted by the Health and Human Services Commission's office of inspector general.

HB 3816 Larson
Relating to the registration as a lobbyist of persons who make certain political contributions.

HB 3882 Larson
Relating to lobbying by former statewide elected officers or members of their staffs; creating a criminal offense.

HB 3903 Burkett
Relating to certain political contributions by judicial candidates and officeholders and certain political committees.
