Relating to the liability of employees of certain real property owners for certain claims arising from construction activities.

HB 1463 Smithee | et al.  
Relating to procedures for asserting claims under the Americans with Disabilities Act; providing a civil penalty.

HB 2069 Shaheen  
Relating to a limitation on civil suits against persons reporting suspicious activity in good faith.
