Relating to the use of the compensatory education allotment for a school district's school guidance and counseling program.

HB 413 Bernal  
Relating to increased flexibility in the use of the Instructional Materials Allotment

HB 884 King, Ken  
Relating to a revision of the essential knowledge and skills of the public school foundation curriculum and proclamations for the production of instructional materials.

Relating to designation of mathematics innovation zones by the commissioner of education and to the establishment of pay for success programs to provide necessary funding.

Relating to a highway toll exemption for public school buses.

HB 2767 Gervin-Hawkins  
Relating to the implementation of certain rules regarding public school accountability adopted by the commissioner of education or the Texas Education Agency.

HB 3209 Gonzales, Larry  
Relating to requiring the Texas Education Agency to enter into a memorandum of understanding with regional day school programs for the deaf regarding performance evaluation requirements for accountability purposes.

HB 3434 Koop  
Relating to requirements for building construction contracts entered into by public school districts.

Relating to the applicability of certain immunity and liability laws to the nonprofit corporation established by the Texas Public Finance Authority to issue revenue bonds to open-enrollment charter schools for those schools to provide educational facilities.

HB 3706 Lucio III  
Relating to certain alternative education programs designed to address workforce development needs for at risk students.

HB 3887 Coleman  
Relating to trauma training for public school personnel.

Relating to staff development and continuing education requirements for public school educators regarding digital education methods.
