Relating to adverse possession of real property by a cotenant heir against other cotenant heirs.

SB 1250 West
Relating to the admissibility of certain evidence in the prosecution of certain offenses involving family violence.

SB 1329 Huffman
Relating to the operation and administration of and practice in courts in the judicial branch of state government.

SB 1362 Campbell | et al.
Relating to notification and informational materials regarding mutual consent voluntary adoption registries.

SCR 3 Creighton
Claiming sovereignty under the Tenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution over all powers not otherwise enumerated and granted to the federal government by the U.S. Constitution, serving notice to the federal government to halt and reverse certain mandates, and providing that certain federal legislation be prohibited or repealed.
