Relating to the pretrial release of a defendant and to funding for judicial continuing legal education.

Relating to preventing racial profiling and video and audio equipment and recordings of certain law enforcement motor vehicle stops; creating an offense.

**SB 1728** Birdwell

Relating to public access to juvenile court proceedings.

**SB 1823** Burton

Relating to a warrant authorizing the search of a cellular telephone or other wireless communications device.

**SB 1857** Whitmire

Relating to the exchange of certain information between the Department of Family and Protective Services and other juvenile service providers.

**SJR 50** Whitmire

Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the denial of pretrial release of a person accused of a noncapital offense if necessary to ensure the person's appearance in court and the safety of the community and the victim of the alleged offense.
