Relating to allowing the placement and maintenance of traffic-control signals in municipalities to permit emergency vehicles to safely enter a highway.

SB 1437 Schwertner

Relating to payment for the use of a highway toll project.

SB 1621 Uresti

Relating to Texas Department of Motor Vehicles and county tax assessor-collector vehicle titling and registration duties and fees associated with those duties.

SB 1834 Buckingham

Relating to the allocation of revenue from certain penalties for transportation project delays.

SB 2103 Garcia

Relating to the authority of certain municipalities to alter prima facie speed limits.

SB 2137 Lucio

Relating to a fee associated with a required inspection of a motor vehicle for certain title transfers; authorizing a fee.

SB 2138 Lucio

Relating to the establishment of a pilot program for the issuance of digital driver's licenses.

SB 2139 Lucio

Relating to the creation of regional transit authorities; granting the power of eminent domain; providing authority to issue bonds and charge fees; creating a criminal offense.

At the Chair's discretion, the Committee may also consider any pending business.
