9	Farm-to-Market Road 2687 and the border of the unincorporated
10	community of Randado is designated as the State Trooper David Lee
11	Nevarez Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any
12	other designation.
13	(b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:
14	(1) design and construct markers indicating the
15	highway number, the designation as the State Trooper David Lee
16	Nevarez Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate information;
17	and
18	(2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
19	appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
