Amend H.B. No. 2115 (senate committee printing) by adding the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

4 SECTION ____. The heading to Section 504.320, 5 Transportation Code, as added by Chapter 708 (H.B. 1128), Acts 6 of the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 504.320. <u>RECIPIENTS OF CERTAIN</u> COMBAT <u>BADGES</u>, <u>MEDALS</u>, 9 OR RIBBONS [ACTION BADGE, <u>MEDAL</u>, OR RIBBON RECIPIENTS].

10 SECTION _____. Section 504.320, Transportation Code, as 11 added by Chapter 708 (H.B. 1128), Acts of the 84th Legislature, 12 Regular Session, 2015, is amended by adding Subsection (c-1) and 13 amending Subsection (d) to read as follows:

14 (c-1) The department shall issue specialty license plates 15 for recipients of the Combat Medical Badge. License plates 16 issued under this subsection must include the Combat Medical 17 Badge emblem and must include the words "Combat Medical Badge" 18 at the bottom of each plate.

(d) A specialty license plate issued under this section 19 for a badge or ribbon that may be awarded more than once shall 20 [For purposes of Subsections (a) and (c), if a branch of the 21 22 United States armed forces awards a Combat Action Badge or 23 Ribbon with a unique emblem for each award of the Combat Action 24 Badge or Ribbon to a recipient, the department shall only issue 25 specialty license plates that] include only the [unique] emblem of the first award badge or ribbon. 26
