Re: Responsibility of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59(d), Texas Constitution.

House Bill (HB) 925, as Filed by Representative Drew Springer- relating to the composition of the board of directors of the Gateway Groundwater Conservation District.

Dear Speaker Bonnen:

The following comments are provided pursuant to the Constitutional requirements referenced above. Under those requirements, the TCEQ must submit, to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Speaker of the House of Representatives, the TCEQ's recommendations on specific legislation affecting water districts. We recommend that these comments be considered in the evaluation of the proposed legislation.

The bill changes the number of the governing board of directors representing the Gateway Groundwater Conservation District (GCD), Chapter §8839, Special District Local Laws Code. The bill amends §8839.051(a), changing the number of board directors to be composed of not more than two directors from each county within the Gateway GCD boundaries and with each county possessing an equal number of board directors. The bill also provides for the directors to change the total number of board directors if the GCD adds territory.
