Re: Responsibility of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59(d), Texas Constitution.

House Bill (HB) 4634, as Filed by Representative Dan Flynn-relating to the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority; following the recommendations of the Sunset Advisory Commission.

Dear Speaker Bonnen:

The following comments are provided pursuant to the Constitutional requirements referenced above. Under those requirements, the TCEQ must submit, to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Speaker of the House of Representatives, the TCEQ's recommendations on specific legislation affecting water districts. We recommend that these comments be considered in the evaluation of the proposed legislation.

The bill provides changes to the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA), Acts of the 43rd Texas Legislature, First Called Session, Chapter 75. The bill amends Section 1A(a), to provide that the GBRA is subject to Sunset Review again in 2031, and every twelve years thereafter. The bill also provides that GBRA is subject to the Texas Water Code (TWC) Chapter 5 pertaining to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), Chapter 7 pertaining to enforcement, Chapter's 11 and 12, both pertaining to water rights, Chapter 17 pertaining to public funding, Chapter 26 pertaining to water quality control, Chapter 30 pertaining to regional waste control, and Texas Health and Safety Code Chapter 366 pertaining to on-site sewage disposal systems.
