Re: Responsibility of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59(d), Texas Constitution

Senate Bill (SB) 2071, as Filed by Senator Judith Zaffirini - Relating to the composition of the port commission of the Port of Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces County, Texas.

Dear Governor Patrick:

The following comments are provided pursuant to the Constitutional requirements referenced above. Under those requirements, the TCEQ must submit, to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Speaker of the House of Representatives, the TCEQ's recommendations on specific legislation affecting water districts. We recommend that these comments be considered in the evaluation of the proposed legislation.

The bill amends Section 1A, Chapter 397, Acts of the 68th Legislature, Regular Session, 1983, as added by Chapter 498, Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, related to the Port of Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces County, Texas (Authority). The bill changes the number of port commission members from seven to nine. The bill also amends Section 2(a), Chapter 397, Acts of the 68th Legislature, Regular Session, 1983, regarding the appointment of port commissioners. The bill specifies that the commissioners court of Nueces County shall appoint three port commissioners, the city council of the City of Corpus Christi shall appoint three port commissioners, and the commissioners court of San Patricio County shall appoint three port commissioners, two of whom server as non-voting commissioners in an advisory capacity only. The bill repeals Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4, Chapter 1334, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003.



S.B. No. 2071

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the composition of the port commission of the Port of Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces County, Texas.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1A, Chapter 397, Acts of the 68th Legislature, Regular Session, 1983, as added by Chapter 498, Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1A. COMPOSITION OF PORT COMMISSION. The port commission is composed of nine [~~seven~~] port commissioners [~~members~~].

SECTION 2. Section 2(a), Chapter 397, Acts of the 68th Legislature, Regular Session, 1983, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Port commissioners are appointed as follows:

(1) the commissioners court [~~The Commissioners Court~~] of Nueces County shall appoint three port commissioners;

(2) the city council of the City of Corpus Christi shall appoint three port commissioners; and

(3) the commissioners court of San Patricio County shall appoint three port commissioners, two of whom serve as non-voting commissioners in an advisory capacity only [~~four members to the port commission, and the City Council of Corpus Christi shall appoint three members to the port commission~~].

SECTION 3. Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4, Chapter 1334, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, are repealed.

1           SECTION 4. Not later than one year after the effective date  
2 of this Act, the commissioners court of San Patricio County shall  
3 appoint two port commissioners to the port commission of the Port of  
4 Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces County, Texas, as provided by  
5 Section 2(a), Chapter 397, Acts of the 68th Legislature, Regular  
6 Session, 1983, as amended by this Act, to serve terms that expire on  
7 dates that preserve the required staggering of terms.

8           SECTION 5. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails  
9 over another Act of the 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019,  
10 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted  
11 codes.

12           SECTION 6. (a) The legal notice of the intention to  
13 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this  
14 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a  
15 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,  
16 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished  
17 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,  
18 Government Code.

19           (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has  
20 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on  
21 Environmental Quality.

22           (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed  
23 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the  
24 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of  
25 representatives within the required time.

26           (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
27 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect

1 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
2 and accomplished.

3           SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
7 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.





