SB 2530, as Filed by Senator Pat Fallon
Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's Comments

The Legislative Budget Board, in cooperation with the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), has determined that:

This bill creates Van Alstyne Municipal Utility District No. 2 of Collin County (District) with the powers and duties of a standard municipal utility district under Water Code Chapters 49 and 54.

Comments on Powers/Duties Different from Similar Types of Districts:

The District must receive consent to the creation of the District from each municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction the District is located prior to holding a confirmation election; the bill requires the TCEQ to appoint the five initial temporary directors upon receipt of a petition from the owners of a majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district; the bill grants the District authority for road projects; the bill allows the district to divide; the District may not annex territory outside the District's boundaries unless the City of Van Alstyne by ordinance or resolution has consented to the annexation; the District may not exercise the power of eminent domain outside the District to acquire a site or easement for a road project or a recreational facility as defined by Section 49.462, Water Code; the bill specifies that at the time of issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of real property in the District; and if the bill does not receive a two-thirds vote of all members elected to each house, the District may not exercise the power of eminent domain.

Overlapping Services: TCEQ does not have mapping information for water and/or wastewater providers because this function was transferred from the TCEQ to the Public Utility Commission on September 1, 2014. As a result, TCEQ is unaware of possible overlapping service providers.

TCEQ's Supervision: As with general law districts, the TCEQ will have general supervisory authority, including bond review authority and review of financial reports.



A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the creation of the Van Alstyne Municipal Utility District No. 2 of Collin County; granting a limited power of eminent domain; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose assessments, fees, and taxes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8048 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 8048. VAN ALSTYNE MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 2 OF

COLLIN COUNTY

SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 8048.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

(2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

(3) "Director" means a board member.

(4) "District" means the Van Alstyne Municipal Utility District No. 2 of Collin County.

Sec. 8048.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

Sec. 8048.0103. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTOR ELECTION REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent

1 directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

2 Sec. 8048.0104. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The
3 temporary directors may not hold an election under Section
4 8048.0103 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or
5 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has
6 consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the
7 district and to the inclusion of land in the district.

8 Sec. 8048.0105. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT.

9 (a) The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit.

10 (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:

11 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by
12 general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and

13 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that
14 relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation,
15 or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
16 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

17 Sec. 8048.0106. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
18 district is initially composed of the territory described by
19 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

20 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
21 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
22 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
23 does not affect the district's:

24 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

25 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
26 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
27 interest on a bond;

1 (3) right to impose a tax; or

2 (4) legality or operation.

3 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

4 Sec. 8048.0201. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
5 governed by a board of five elected directors.

6 (b) Except as provided by Section 8048.0202, directors
7 serve staggered four-year terms.

8 Sec. 8048.0202. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after
9 September 1, 2019, the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed
10 value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to
11 the commission requesting that the commission appoint as temporary
12 directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission
13 shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons named in the
14 petition.

15 (b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

16 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under
17 Section 8048.0103; or

18 (2) September 1, 2023.

19 (c) If permanent directors have not been elected under
20 Section 8048.0103 and the terms of the temporary directors have
21 expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or
22 reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that
23 expire on the earlier of:

24 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under
25 Section 8048.0103; or

26 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the
27 appointment or reappointment.

1 (d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a
2 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district
3 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the
4 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five
5 persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as
6 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the
7 petition.

8 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

9 Sec. 8048.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district
10 has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for
11 which the district is created.

12 Sec. 8048.0302. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND
13 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the
14 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
15 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
16 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

17 Sec. 8048.0303. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under Section
18 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may design,
19 acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, operate,
20 maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for
21 operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
22 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

23 Sec. 8048.0304. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A
24 road project must meet all applicable construction standards,
25 zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each
26 municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial
27 jurisdiction the road project is located.

1 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits
2 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road
3 project must meet all applicable construction standards,
4 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which
5 the road project is located.

6 (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the
7 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and
8 specifications of the road project.

9 Sec. 8048.0305. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT
10 ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all
11 applicable requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is
12 adopted under Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that
13 consents to the creation of the district or to the inclusion of land
14 in the district.

15 Sec. 8048.0306. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may
16 be divided into two or more new districts only if:

- 17 (1) the district has no outstanding bonded debt;
18 (2) the district is not imposing ad valorem taxes; and
19 (3) the City of Van Alstyne by ordinance or resolution
20 has consented to the division of the district.

21 (b) This chapter applies to any new district created by the
22 division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and
23 duties of the district.

24 (c) Any new district created by the division of the district
25 may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land
26 outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act enacting this
27 chapter.

1 (d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition
2 signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of
3 the real property in the district, may adopt an order dividing the
4 district.

5 (e) The board may adopt an order dividing the district
6 before or after the date the board holds an election under Section
7 8048.0103 to confirm the district's creation.

8 (f) An order dividing the district shall:

9 (1) name each new district;

10 (2) include the metes and bounds description of the
11 territory of each new district;

12 (3) appoint temporary directors for each new district;

13 and

14 (4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities
15 between or among the new districts.

16 (g) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of
17 an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order
18 with the commission and record the order in the real property
19 records of each county in which the district is located.

20 (h) Any new district created by the division of the district
21 shall hold a confirmation and directors' election as required by
22 Section 8048.0103. If the voters of a new district do not confirm
23 the creation of the new district, the assets, obligations,
24 territory, and governance of the new district revert to the
25 original district.

26 (i) Municipal consent to the creation of the district and to
27 the inclusion of land in the district granted under Section

1 8048.0104 acts as municipal consent to the creation of any new
2 district created by the division of the district and to the
3 inclusion of land in the new district.

4 (j) Any new district created by the division of the district
5 must hold an election as required by this chapter to obtain voter
6 approval before the district may impose a maintenance tax or issue
7 bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes.

8 Sec. 8048.0307. LIMITATION ON ANNEXATION. The district may
9 not annex territory outside the area described by Section 2 of the
10 Act enacting this chapter unless the City of Van Alstyne by
11 ordinance or resolution has consented to the annexation.

12 Sec. 8048.0308. LIMITATION ON USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN. (a)
13 The district may not exercise the power of eminent domain outside
14 the district to acquire a site or easement for:

- 15 (1) a road project authorized by Section 8048.0303; or
16 (2) a recreational facility as defined by Section
17 49.462, Water Code.

18 (b) The district may not exercise the power of eminent
19 domain in the corporate limits of the City of Van Alstyne unless the
20 city by ordinance or resolution has consented to the exercise of
21 eminent domain authority.

22 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

23 Sec. 8048.0401. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a)
24 The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
25 obligations secured by:

- 26 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or
27 (2) contract payments described by Section 8048.0403.

1 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner
2 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval
3 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds
4 payable from ad valorem taxes.

5 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem
6 taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a
7 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an
8 election held for that purpose.

9 Sec. 8048.0402. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
10 authorized at an election held under Section 8048.0401, the
11 district may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable
12 property in the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water
13 Code.

14 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
15 exceed the rate approved at the election.

16 Sec. 8048.0403. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with
17 Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than
18 an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from
19 the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of
20 the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters
21 voting at an election held for that purpose.

22 (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a
23 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by
24 the board without further voter approval.

25 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS

26 Sec. 8048.0501. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
27 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations

1 payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,
2 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any
3 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district
4 purpose.

5 Sec. 8048.0502. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district
6 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the
7 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing
8 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all
9 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner
10 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

11 Sec. 8048.0503. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of
12 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations
13 issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad
14 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the
15 real property in the district.

16 SECTION 2. The Van Alstyne County Municipal Utility
17 District No. 2 of Collin County initially includes all the
18 territory contained in the following area:

20 BEING a tract of land situated in the David Arnspiger Survey,
21 Abstract No. 15, the J. W. Curtis Survey, Abstract No. 1077, the E.

23 Abstract No. 431, the W. P. Burns Survey, Abstract No. 100, the



Pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, notice is hereby given of the intention to apply to the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas at its regular session in Austin, Texas for the introduction of a bill, the substance of the contemplated law being as follows:

An act relating to the creation of Van Alstyne Municipal Utility District No. 2; providing authority to impose a tax and issue bonds; granting a limited power of eminent domain.
