Amend CSHB 3 (senate committee report) in SECTION 1.025 of the bill, in transferred, redesignated, and amended Section 48.106, Education Code, by striking page 20, lines 9 through 24, and substituting the following:

(c) <u>At least 58 percent of the funds</u> [Funds] allocated under this section[, other than an indirect cost allotment established under State Board of Education rule,] must be used in providing career and technology education programs in grades <u>9</u> [nine] through 12 or career and technology education programs for students with disabilities in grades <u>7</u> [seven] through 12 under Sections 29.182, 29.183, and 29.184.

(d) <u>Out of the total statewide allotment for career and</u> <u>technology education under this section, the commissioner shall</u> <u>annually set aside \$8 million to fund the grant program for P-TECH</u> <u>schools under Section 29.556, in addition to other funds</u> <u>appropriated for that purpose. After deducting the amount set aside</u> <u>under this subsection from the total statewide allotment for career</u> <u>and technology education under this section, the commissioner shall</u> <u>proportionately reduce each school district's allotment under this</u> <u>section and allocate funds to each district accordingly.</u> [The <u>commissioner shall conduct a cost-benefit</u>
