Amend CSHB 650 (house committee report) as follows:

- (1) Strike page 3, line 17, through page 4, line 1, and substitute the following:
- (a) The department may not <u>place</u> [<u>use</u>] restraints <u>around the</u> <u>ankles</u>, <u>legs</u>, <u>or waist</u> [<u>to control the movement</u>] of a pregnant woman in the custody of the department at any time <u>after the woman's</u> <u>pregnancy has been confirmed by a medical professional</u> [<u>during which the woman is in labor or delivery or recovering from delivery</u>], unless the director, the [<u>or</u>] director's designee, or a <u>medical professional</u> determines that the use of restraints is necessary <u>based</u> on a reasonable belief that the [to:
- [(1) ensure the safety and security of the] woman will harm herself, [or] her infant, or any other person [department or medical personnel, or any member of the public;] or
- [(2) prevent a substantial risk that the woman] will attempt escape.
 - (2) On page 5, line 8, strike "a plastic".
