15 A.1.5, Commitment Diversion Initiatives, A.1.7, Mental Health
16 Services Grants, and A.1.8, Regional Diversion Alternatives, shall
17 be distributed as" and substitute "Out of funds appropriated above
18 in Strategy A.1.2, Basic Probation Supervision, the Juvenile
19 Justice Department shall allocate \$5,000,000 for the state fiscal
20 biennium ending August 31, 2021, for"; and

21 (B) immediately after the last sentence of the rider,
22 insert "The Juvenile Justice Department shall give priority in
23 awarding the grants to local probation departments in rural
24 counties.".

31 revenue appropriations for Strategy A.1.1, Conduct Hearings (page

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1 VIII-1), by \$250,000 for the state fiscal biennium ending August
2 31, 2021.

3 (19) In Article VIII of the bill, in the appropriations to
4 the Racing Commission, reduce the general revenue appropriations
5 for Strategy A.2.1, Texas Bred Incentive Program (page VIII-45), by
6 \$250,000 for the state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2021.
