- 1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 1 (house committee report) as follows:
- 2 (1) In Article I of the bill, reduce the appropriations from
- 3 the general revenue fund to the Trusteed Programs within the Office
- 4 of the Governor for Strategy A.2.3, State-Federal Relations (page
- 5 I-51), by \$950,000 for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2020,
- 6 and by \$950,000 for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2021.
- 7 (2) In Article II of the bill, increase the appropriations
- 8 from the general revenue fund to the Department of Family and
- 9 Protective Services for Strategy E.1.1, Central Administration
- 10 (page II-2), by \$900,000 for the state fiscal year ending August 31,
- 11 2020, and by \$900,000 for the state fiscal year ending August 31,
- 12 2021.
- 13 (3) In Article II of the bill, following the appropriations
- 14 to the Department of Family and Protective Services (page II-3),
- 15 add the following appropriately numbered rider:
- 16 ____. Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation Prevention
- 17 and Intervention. Out of funds appropriated above in Strategy
- 18 E.1.1, Central Administration, the Department of Family and
- 19 Protective Services shall allocate a minimum of \$900,000 each state
- 20 fiscal year to the Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation
- 21 division.
- 22 (4) In Article II of the bill, increase the appropriations
- 23 from the general revenue fund to the Health and Human Services
- 24 Commission for Strategy D.1.1, Women's Health Programs (page
- 25 II-34), by \$50,000 for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2020,
- 26 and by \$50,000 for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2021.
- 27 (5) In Article II of the bill, following the appropriations
- 28 to the Health and Human Services Commission (page II-37), add the
- 29 following appropriately numbered rider:

- 1 ____. Texas Human Trafficking Resource Center. Out of funds
- 2 appropriated above in Strategy D.1.1, Women's Health Programs, the
- 3 Health and Human Services Commission shall allocate a minimum of
- 4 \$50,000 each state fiscal year to the Texas Human Trafficking
- 5 Resource Center.
- 6 (6) Adjust totals and methods of financing accordingly.
