- 11 (1) the Department of Family and Protective Services;
- 12 (2) the Department of State Health Services;
- 13 (3) the Department of Criminal Justice;
- 14 (4) the Texas Education Agency;
- 15 (5) the Juvenile Justice Department;
- 16 (6) the Veterans Commission; and
- 17 (7) Trusteed Programs Within the Office of the
- 18 Governor.
- 19 (b) Each agency or entity whose general revenue
- 20 appropriations are reduced by Subsection (a) of this rider may
- 21 reallocate the general revenue appropriated to it for any strategy
- 22 as necessary to accommodate the reductions.
- 23 (c) Notwithstanding other provisions of this Article, the
- 24 appropriations made to the Health and Human Services Commission for
- 25 Strategy D.2.3, Community Mental Health Crisis Services, are
