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- 1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 1 (house committee printing) in ARTICLE II
- 2 of the bill, following the appropriations to the Health and Human
- 3 Services Commission (page II-37), by adding the following
- 4 appropriately numbered rider and renumbering subsequent riders
- 5 accordingly:
- 6 ____. Alternatives to Abortion Program.
- 7 (a) Method of Finance and Administration. Notwithstanding
- 8 any contrary provision of this Article, the Health and Human
- 9 Services Commission may not spend any appropriated funds for
- 10 Strategy D.1.2, Alternatives to Abortion, other than funds from the
- 11 General Revenue Fund. Out of the amounts appropriated above for
- 12 Strategy D.1.2, the commission shall allocate an amount as
- 13 necessary for the purposes of funding one FTE position for the
- 14 Health and Human Services Commission to implement and administer
- 15 the strategy and ensure contractor compliance with all relevant
- 16 law.
- 17 (b) Provider Eligibility.
- 18 (1) The Health and Human Services Commission may not
- 19 provide funds appropriated for Strategy D.1.2, Alternatives to
- 20 Abortion, to a provider for use to pay the direct or indirect costs,
- 21 including marketing, overhead, rent, phones, and utilities, of
- 22 abortion procedures provided by contractors of the commission.
- 23 (2) The Health and Human Services Commission may not
- 24 provide funds appropriated for Strategy D.1.2, Alternatives to
- 25 Abortion, to a provider for use by an individual or entity that,
- 26 during the period for which funds under this Act are appropriated:
- 27 (A) performs or makes a referral for an abortion
- 28 procedure that is not reimbursable under the state's Medicaid
- 29 program;

- 1 (B) is commonly owned, managed, or controlled by
- 2 an entity that performs an abortion procedure that is not
- 3 reimbursable under the state's Medicaid program; or
- 4 (C) is a franchise or affiliate of an entity that
- 5 performs an abortion procedure that is not reimbursable under the
- 6 state's Medicaid program.
- 7 (3) The Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 8 include in its financial audit a review of appropriated funds to
- 9 ensure compliance with this rider.
- 10 (c) Services Covered. To the extent authorized by general
- 11 law, the Health and Human Services Commission may use funds
- 12 appropriated for Strategy D.1.2, Alternatives to Abortion, to
- 13 reimburse services that improve the pregnancy or parenting
- 14 situation and are eligible for reimbursement through Strategy
- 15 D.1.2, including:
- 16 (1) parenting skills classes;
- 17 (2) job skill training and job placement assistance;
- 18 (3) distribution of infant and child care supplies
- 19 such as car seats, diapers, and formula; and
- 20 (4) pregnancy options counseling.
- 21 (d) Contracting Policies. The Health and Human Services
- 22 Commission shall extend current contracts with modifications in
- 23 accordance with this rider through August 31, 2021, and make those
- 24 funds available to contractors under Strategy D.1.2, Alternatives
- 25 to Abortion, not later than the first day of the state fiscal
- 26 biennium ending on August 31, 2021, if the contractors are in good
- 27 standing with the commission. The funds must be apportioned among
- 28 the contractors according to the number of clients that were seen in
- 29 the physical presence of a contractor during the first six months of
- 30 the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2019. The FTE described by
- 31 Subsection (a) of this rider shall oversee contracting and ensure

- 1 compliance with commission contracting procedures and all other
- 2 relevant laws and policies.
