- 1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 1 (house committee printing) in Article II
- 2 of the bill, following the appropriations to the Department of
- 3 Family and Protective Services (page II-3), by adding the following
- 4 appropriately numbered rider:
- 5 ____. IMPACT Modernization Strategic Plan. (a) It is the
- 6 intent of the legislature that, out of funds appropriated to the
- 7 Department of Family and Protective Services above for Strategy
- 8 F.1.1, Agency-Wide Automated Systems, the amount of \$750,000 shall
- 9 be allocated for the department to contract with an independent
- 10 third party to develop a strategic plan for modernizing the
- 11 department's case tracking and information management system,
- 12 including ensuring the interoperability of the department's system
- 13 with the information technology systems used by single-source
- 14 continuum contractors in community-based care. The plan must
- 15 include:
- 16 (1) a cost-benefit analysis of continuing to modernize
- 17 the department's case tracking and information management system
- 18 compared to implementing a different information technology
- 19 system;
- 20 (2) a detailed analysis of the methods for integrating
- 21 the department's case tracking and information management system
- 22 with the information technology systems used by single-source
- 23 continuum contractors;
- 24 (3) strategies for reducing long term the number of
- 25 full-time equivalents associated with the department's information
- 26 technology systems as efficiencies are achieved; and
- 27 (4) provisions relating to the oversight of the
- 28 third-party information technology contractor.
- 29 (b) Contingent on the enactment of H.B. No. 1096 or similar

- 1 legislation of the 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019,
- 2 relating to the modernization of information technology systems
- 3 used by state agencies, the department shall include an analysis of
- 4 the feasibility of using funds made available for information
- 5 technology systems modernization under H.B. No. 1096 or similar
- 6 legislation to modernize the department's case tracking and
- 7 information management system.
- 8 (c) Not later than November 1, 2020, the Department of
- 9 Family and Protective Services shall submit to the Governor, the
- 10 Lieutenant Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
- 11 the Senate Finance Committee, the House Appropriations Committee,
- 12 the Senate Health and Human Services Committee, the House Human
- 13 Services Committee, and the Legislative Budget Board a report on
- 14 the findings regarding the development of the strategic plan
- 15 required under Subsection (a).
