4 SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 6.03(a), Tax Code, is amended to read  
5 as follows:

6 (a) The appraisal district is governed by a board of  
7 directors. Five directors are appointed by the taxing units that  
8 participate in the district as provided by this section. If the  
9 county assessor-collector is not appointed to the board, the county  
10 assessor-collector serves as a nonvoting director. The county  
11 assessor-collector is ineligible to serve if the board enters into  
12 a contract under Section 6.05(b) or if the commissioners court of  
13 the county enters into a contract under Section 6.24(b). To be  
14 eligible to serve on the board of directors, an individual other  
15 than a county assessor-collector serving as a nonvoting director  
16 must be a resident of the district and must have resided in the  
17 district for at least two years immediately preceding the date the  
18 individual takes office. Except as provided by this subsection, an  
19 ~~[An] individual [who] is ineligible [otherwise eligible]~~ to serve  
20 on the board if the individual is an officer or employee ~~[is not~~  
21 ~~ineligible because of membership on the governing body of a taxing~~  
22 ~~unit. An employee]~~ of a taxing unit that participates in the  
23 district ~~[is not eligible to serve on the board unless the~~  
24 ~~individual is also a member of the governing body or an elected~~  
25 ~~official of a taxing unit that participates in the district].~~

26 SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 6.03(a), Tax Code, as amended by this  
27 Act, does not affect the right of a person serving on the board of  
28 directors of an appraisal district on January 1, 2020, to complete  
29 the person's term on the board.
