Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Education Code, is 3 amended by adding Section 42.168 to read as follows: 4 Sec. 42.168. SCHOOL SAFETY ALLOTMENT. (a) From funds 5 appropriated for that purpose, the commissioner shall provide to 6 a school district an annual allotment in the amount provided by 7 appropriation for each student in average daily attendance. 8 (b) Funds allocated under this section must be used to improve 9 school safety and security, including costs associated with: 10 (1) securing school facilities, including: 11 (A) improvements to school infrastructure; 12 (B) the use or installation of physical barriers; 13 14 and (C) the purchase and maintenance of: 15 16 (i) security cameras or other security 17 equipment; and (ii) technology, including communications 18 systems or devices, that facilitates communication and information 19 sharing between students, school personnel, and first responders 20 21 in an emergency; (2) providing security for the district, including: 22 23 (A) employing school district peace officers, 24 private security officers, and school marshals; and

(B) collaborating with local law enforcement

- 1 agencies, such as entering into a memorandum of understanding for
- 2 the assignment of school resource officers to schools in the
- 3 district; and
- 4 (3) school safety and security training and planning,
- 5 including:
- 6 (A) active shooter and emergency response training;
- 7 (B) prevention and treatment programs relating to
- 8 addressing adverse childhood experiences; and
- 9 (C) the prevention, identification, and management
- 10 of emergencies and threats, including:
- 11 <u>(i) providing mental health personnel and</u>
- 12 support;
- (ii) providing behavioral health services; and
- 14 <u>(iii) establishing threat reporting systems.</u>
- 15 (c) A school district may use funds allocated under this
- 16 section for equipment or software that is used for a school safety
- 17 and security purpose and an instructional purpose, provided that
- 18 the instructional use does not compromise the safety and security
- 19 purpose of the equipment or software.
- 20 (d) A school district that is required to take action under
- 21 Chapter 41 to reduce its wealth per student to the equalized wealth
- 22 <u>level is entitled to a credit, in the amount of the allotments to</u>
- 23 which the district is to receive as provided by appropriation,
- 24 against the total amount required under Section 41.093 for the
- 25 <u>district to purchase attendance credits.</u>
- 26 (e) The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this
- 27 section.
