| 18 | EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM. (a) From funds appropriated or available |
| L9 | for the purpose, the commissioner, in cooperation with an |
| 20 | appropriate private entity, shall conduct a study regarding the |
| 21 | summer career and technology education grant program established |
| 22 | under Section 29.194. The study must analyze: |
| 23 | (1) the success of the grant program; |

- 9 (c) The commissioner may solicit and accept gifts,
- 10 donations, or other contributions for the study and report under
- 11 this section.
- 12 (d) This section expires September 1, 2021.
