1	Amend C.S.H.B. 1523 (house committee printing) as follows:
2	(1) In ARTICLE 1 of the bill, add the following appropriately
3	numbered SECTION and renumber subsequent sections of that article
4	accordingly:
5	SECTION 1 Section 1071.254(a), Occupations Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) An applicant for registration as a registered
8	professional land surveyor must:
9	(1) hold a certificate as a surveyor-in-training;
10	(2) have at least two years of experience satisfactory
11	to the board as a surveyor-in-training in performing surveying in
12	delegated responsible charge as a subordinate to a surveyor
13	registered or licensed to engage in the practice of surveying in
14	this state or in another state having registration or licensing
15	requirements equivalent to the requirements of this state; and
16	(3) [if the application is filed after January 1, 2003,
17	have earned <u>an associate or</u> [a] bachelor's degree from an
18	accredited institution of higher education that included at least
19	$16 \frac{32}{32}$ semester hours in a combination of courses acceptable to the
20	board in:
21	(A) civil engineering;
22	(B) land surveying;
23	(C) mathematics;
24	(D) photogrammetry;
25	(E) forestry;
26	(F) land law; or
27	(G) the physical sciences.
28	(2) In ARTICLE 3 of the bill, add the following appropriately

- 2 SECTION 3. . Section 1071.254(a), Occupations Code, as
- 3 amended by this Act, applies only to an application for
- 4 registration as a registered professional land surveyor that is
- 5 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. An application
- 6 for a registration that was filed before the effective date of
- 7 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 8 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect
- 9 for that purpose.
