FLOOR AMENDMENT NO.\_\_\_\_\_\_

- 1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 1545 (house committee printing) as
- 2 follows:
- 3 (1) On page 92, strike lines 20 through 24 and substitute
- 4 the following:
- 5 may temporarily sell wine and malt beverages under Subsection (a)
- 6 for a length of time that does not exceed the length of time
- 7 established by a rule adopted by the commission under Subsection
- 8 (c)(4).
- 9 (2) On page 100, line 22, between "beverages" and "at:",
- 10 insert "for a length of time that does not exceed the length of time
- 11 established by a rule adopted by the commission under Subsection
- 12 (c)(4)".
- 13 (3) On page 105, line 10, between "held" and the period,
- 14 insert "for a length of time that does not exceed the duration for
- 15 the permit established by a rule adopted by the commission under
- 16 Section 30.08".
- 17 (4) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to
- 18 the bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
- 19 SECTION \_\_\_\_. Effective September 1, 2019, Section 27.02,
- 20 Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 27.02. FEE. The state fee for a temporary wine and
- 22 beer retailer's permit is \$10 for each day the permit is valid
- 23 [\$30]. No refund shall be allowed for the surrender or nonuse of
- 24 the permit.
- 25 SECTION \_\_\_\_. Effective September 1, 2019, Section 27.03,
- 26 Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 27 Sec. 27.03. DURATION OF PERMIT. (a) A [Except as provided
- 28 by Subsection (b), a] temporary wine and beer retailer's permit may
- 29 be issued for the number of days requested in the application, not

- 1 to exceed the length of the event at which the permit holder will be
- 2 selling wine, beer, and malt liquor [a period of not more than four
- 3 days].
- 4 (b) The commission by rule shall establish the maximum
- 5 <u>length of time a [A]</u> temporary wine and beer retailer's permit
- 6 holder [issued under Section 27.07] may sell wine, beer, and malt
- 7 liquor at the same location under a permit issued under this
- 8 subchapter [be issued for a period of five days. On notice to the
- 9 commission, the commission may extend the permit for one additional
- 10 day to accommodate the postponement of scheduled racing events due
- 11 to an act of nature].
- 12 SECTION \_\_\_\_. Effective September 1, 2019, Subchapter B,
- 13 Chapter 27, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 SUBCHAPTER B. SPECIAL EVENT [THREE-DAY] WINE AND BEER PERMIT
- 15 Sec. 27.11. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. The holder of a special
- 16 event [three-day] wine and beer permit may sell for consumption on
- 17 the premises for which the permit is issued, but not for resale,
- 18 wine, beer, and malt liquors containing alcohol in excess of
- 19 one-half of one percent by volume but not more than 17 percent by
- 20 volume.
- 21 Sec. 27.12. FEE. The state fee for a special event
- 22 [three-day] wine and beer permit is \$10 for each day the permit is
- 23 valid [\$30].
- 24 Sec. 27.125. DURATION OF PERMIT. (a) A special event wine
- 25 and beer permit may be issued for the number of days requested in
- 26 the application, not to exceed the length of the event at which the
- 27 permit holder will be selling wine, beer, and malt liquor.
- 28 (b) The commission by rule shall establish the maximum
- 29 length of time a special event wine and beer permit holder may sell
- 30 wine, beer, and malt liquor at the same location under a permit
- 31 issued under this subchapter.

- Sec. 27.13. ISSUANCE OF PERMIT. (a) The commission may
- 2 issue a special event [three-day] wine and beer permit directly to a
- 3 nonprofit charitable, civic, or religious organization for the
- 4 temporary serving of wine and beer at a picnic, celebration, or
- 5 similar event sponsored by the organization.
- 6 (b) The commission by rule may limit the number of special
- 7 event [three-day] wine and beer permits issued in each calendar
- 8 year to a single nonprofit charitable, civic, or religious
- 9 organization for events sponsored by that organization.
- 10 (c) If a special event [three-day] wine and beer permit is
- 11 issued for a premises in an area in which the sale of beer for
- 12 on-premise consumption has been authorized by a local option
- 13 election, but the sale of wine for on-premise consumption has not
- 14 been authorized, then the permittee is only authorized to sell
- 15 beer.
- 16 Sec. 27.14. APPLICATION OF WINE AND BEER RETAILER'S PERMIT
- 17 PROVISIONS. A provision of this code that applies to a wine and
- 18 beer retailer permit applies to a special event [three-day] wine
- 19 and beer permit unless the provision conflicts with a provision of
- 20 this subchapter.
- Sec. 27.15. RULES. The commission  $\frac{\text{shall}}{\text{shall}}$  [may] adopt rules
- 22 as necessary to implement and administer this subchapter.
- SECTION \_\_\_\_. Effective September 1, 2019, Chapter 30,
- 24 Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended by adding Section 30.025 to
- 25 read as follows:
- Sec. 30.025. DURATION OF PERMIT. (a) A daily temporary
- 27 mixed beverage permit may be issued for the number of days requested
- 28 in the application, not to exceed the length of the event at which
- 29 the permit holder will be selling authorized alcoholic beverages.
- 30 (b) The commission by rule shall establish the maximum
- 31 length of time a daily temporary mixed beverage permit holder may

- 1 sell authorized alcoholic beverages at the same location under a
- 2 permit issued under this chapter.
- 3 SECTION \_\_\_\_. Effective September 1, 2019, Section 30.03(a),
- 4 Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) [The commission may, in its discretion, issue on a
- 6 temperary basis a daily temperary mixed beverage permit.] A daily
- 7 temporary mixed beverage permit may be issued only to a holder of a
- 8 mixed beverage permit for the temporary sale of authorized
- 9 alcoholic beverages at picnics, celebrations, or similar events, or
- 10 to a political party or political association supporting a
- 11 candidate for public office or a proposed amendment to the Texas
- 12 Constitution or other ballot measure, to an organization formed for
- 13 a specific charitable or civic purpose, to a fraternal organization
- 14 in existence for over five years with a regular membership, or to a
- 15 religious organization. The commission shall not issue more than
- 16 10 temporary mixed beverage permits in each calendar year to a
- 17 person who does not also hold a mixed beverage permit.
- 18 SECTION \_\_\_\_. Effective September 1, 2019, Section 72.02,
- 19 Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 72.02. FEE. The state fee for a temporary license is
- 21 \$7.50 for each day the license is valid [\$30]. No refund shall be
- 22 allowed for the surrender or nonuse of a temporary license.
- 23 SECTION \_\_\_\_. Effective September 1, 2019, Section 72.03,
- 24 Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 25 Sec. 72.03. DURATION OF LICENSE. A temporary license may be
- 26 issued for the number of days requested in the application, not to
- 27 exceed the length of the event at which the license holder will be
- 28 selling wine, beer, and malt liquor [a period of not more than four
- 29 days].
