2 (1) On page 43, line 27, strike "or".

3 (2) On page 44, line 1, strike "~~[, or private security~~
4 ~~consultant company]~~" and substitute ", or private security
5 consultant company".

6 (3) On page 68, strike lines 22-27 and substitute the
7 following:

8 (I) [~~(K)~~] a private investigator;

9 (J) [~~(L)~~] a private security consultant;

10 (K) [~~(M)~~] a security salesperson; or

11 (L) [~~(N)~~] an individual whose duties include
12 performing another activity for which an individual license
13 [~~endorsement~~] is required under Subsection (e); or

14 (4) On page 76, line 15, strike "~~[AND SECURITY SALESPERSON]~~"
15 and substitute "AND SECURITY SALESPERSON".

16 (5) On page 76, line 17, strike "~~[or security salesperson]~~"
17 and substitute "or security salesperson".

18 (6) On page 77, line 17, strike "~~[or a security~~
19 ~~salesperson]~~" and substitute "or a security salesperson".

20 (7) On page 88, strike lines 2-10 and substitute the
21 following:

22 (2) an alarm systems installer who installs,
23 maintains, or repairs only personal emergency response systems;

24 (3) [~~a manager or branch office manager of an alarm~~
25 ~~systems company described by Subdivision (1)~~];

26 [~~(4)~~] a security salesperson who is employed by an alarm
27 systems company described by Subdivision (1) to sell services
28 offered by the company; and

29 (4) [~~(5)~~] an owner [~~, officer, partner, or~~

1 ~~shareholder~~] of an alarm systems company described by Subdivision
2 (1).

3 (8) On page 104, lines 2 and 12, strike Subdivisions (21)
4 and (31) and renumber the subdivisions of that subsection
5 appropriately.

6 (9) On page 106, strike lines 15-26 and substitute the
7 following:

8 SECTION 5.117. On September 1, 2019, any license,
9 registration, endorsement, or other authorization required to
10 operate as a guard dog company or trainer of a dog used to protect
11 persons or property or to conduct investigations, as described by
12 Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, as that chapter existed immediately
13 before the effective date of this Act, expires.

14 (10) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to
15 ARTICLE 5 of the bill and renumber the sections of that article
16 accordingly:

17 SECTION 5.____. Section 1702.1045, Occupations Code, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Sec. 1702.1045. PRIVATE SECURITY CONSULTING COMPANY. A
20 person acts as a private security consulting company for purposes
21 of this chapter if the person:

22 (1) consults, advises, trains, or specifies or
23 recommends products, services, methods, or procedures in the
24 security or loss prevention industry;

25 (2) provides a service described by Subdivision (1) on
26 an independent basis and without being affiliated with a particular
27 service or product; and

28 (3) meets the experience requirements established by
29 the commission [~~board~~].
