1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 616 (house committee report) as follows:

2 (1) On page 54, strike lines 24 and 25 and substitute the  
3 following:

4 SECTION 5.042. Section 1702.124, Occupations Code, is  
5 amended by amending Subsections (a), (b), (c), and (f) and adding  
6 Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

7 (2) On page 55, between lines 14 and 15, insert the  
8 following:

9 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), the [The]  
10 insurance policy must contain minimum limits of:

11 (1) \$100,000 for each occurrence for bodily injury and  
12 property damage;

13 (2) \$50,000 for each occurrence for personal injury;  
14 and

15 (3) a total aggregate amount of \$200,000 for all  
16 occurrences.

17 (c-1) If the application is for a license to act as a guard  
18 company, the insurance policy must contain minimum limits of:

19 (1) \$1 million for each occurrence for bodily injury  
20 and property damage;

21 (2) \$1 million for each occurrence for personal  
22 injury; and

23 (3) a total aggregate amount of \$2 million for all  
24 occurrences.

25 (3) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to  
26 ARTICLE 5 of the bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the  
27 ARTICLE accordingly:

28 SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 1702.124(c-1), Occupations Code, as  
29 added by this Act, applies only to an applicant for or holder of a

1 license under Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, on or after January  
2 1, 2020.
