2	(1) On page 5, strike lines 14 through 16 and substitute the
3	following:

6	under the direct supervision of a journeyman or master plumber as a
7	plumber's apprentice; or
8	(ii) successfully completed a coherent
9	sequence of courses in the plumbing trade that are offered through a
10	career and technology education program, as described by Section
11	<u>1301.3542;</u>
12	(2) On page 22, between lines 12 and 13, add the following
13	appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill:
14	SECTION Subchapter G, Chapter 1301, Occupations Code,
15	is amended by adding Section 1301.3542 to read as follows:
16	Sec. 1301.3542. CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION PROGRAM FOR
17	TRADESMAN PLUMBER-LIMITED LICENSE; INSTRUCTORS. (a)
18	Notwithstanding Section 1301.354, a person who successfully
19	completes a coherent sequence of courses in the plumbing trade that
20	are offered through a career and technology education program in
21	accordance with Subchapter F, Chapter 29, Education Code, may apply
22	for and take an examination for a license as a tradesman
23	plumber-limited license holder. The department may not require the
24	person to register as a plumber's apprentice, pay any fee, or comply
25	with Section 1301.354 or any other requirement of this chapter that
26	applies to a person's eligibility to apply for and take the
27	examination.
28	(b) A student of any age enrolled in a high school is
29	eligible to take the sequence of courses described by Subsection

- 1 (a) without registering as a plumber's apprentice, paying any
- 2 registration fee, or complying with Section 1301.354 or any other
- 3 requirement of this chapter that applies to enrolling or
- 4 participating in those courses.
- 5 (c) If an applicant described by Subsection (a)
- 6 successfully passes the examination for a license as a tradesman
- 7 plumber-limited license holder, the department shall issue the
- 8 license to the applicant.
- 9 (d) The commission shall develop the courses described by
- 10 Subsection (a). The courses must be approved by the State Board of
- 11 Education.
- 12 (e) The courses must include an appropriate number of hours
- 13 of classroom instruction and a practical component. The department
- 14 may credit on-the-job training toward meeting the requirements
- 15 under the practical component.
- 16 (f) A person may not provide instruction in a career and
- 17 technology education program described by this section unless the
- 18 person is licensed under this chapter as a master plumber,
- 19 journeyman plumber, or plumbing inspector.
- 20 (g) A person described by Subsection (f) may provide the
- 21 instruction in a full-time or part-time capacity as an employee,
- 22 contractor, or volunteer of a high school.
- 23 (h) The commission may adopt rules necessary to implement
- 24 this section, including procedures to verify a student's successful
- 25 completion of the sequence of courses described by Subsection (a).
- 26 (3) On page 26, between lines 13 and 14, insert the
- 27 following:
- 28 (d) A person who is employed by, under contract with, or
- 29 engaged as a volunteer by a school to provide instruction in a
- 30 career and technology education program described by Section
- 31 1301.3542 and provides meaningful course instruction in the

- 2 Section 1301.407, is not required to pay a fee to renew the person's
- 3 license under this chapter.
- 4 (4) On page 26, strike lines 14 and 15 and substitute the
- 5 following:
- 6 SECTION 35. Section 1301.404, Occupations Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsections (a), (c), (d), (e), and (f) and adding
- 8 Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 9 (5) On page 27, between lines 16 and 17, insert the
- 10 following:
- 11 (g) A person who is employed by, under contract with, or
- 12 engaged as a volunteer by a school to provide instruction in a
- 13 career and technology education program described by Section
- 14 1301.3542 and provides meaningful course instruction in the
- 15 program, as determined in accordance with rules adopted under
- 16 Section 1301.407, may renew the person's license and any
- 17 endorsement without complying with Subsection (b) if the person
- 18 completes the hours of continuing professional education required
- 19 by that subsection every three years.
- 20 (6) On page 28, between lines 26 and 27, insert the

- 23 is amended by adding Section 1301.407 to read as follows:
- 24 Sec. 1301.407. PROCEDURES FOR VERIFYING CERTAIN
- 25 EXEMPTIONS. The commission, in consultation with the State Board
- 26 of Education, may adopt rules as necessary to verify whether a
- 27 person qualifies for an exemption from the required renewal fee, as
- 28 described by Section 1301.401(d), or an exemption from required
- 29 continuing professional education, as described by Section
- 30 1301.404(g), including rules for obtaining and evaluating written
- 31 verification from the applicable school of the person's provision

- 1 of meaningful course instruction in a career and technology
- 2 education program described by Section 1301.3542.
- 3 (7) Renumber the SECTIONS of the bill accordingly.
