5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 531.024141 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 531.024141. MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM SERVICES
8	FOR CERTAIN CHILDREN. (a) The commission shall provide:
9	(1) medical transportation program services to an
10	eligible child described by Subsection (b); and
11	(2) reimbursement for those services.
12	(b) A child is eligible to receive medical transportation
13	program services under this section:
14	(1) if the child is younger than 13 years of age;
15	(2) if the child's mother is:
16	(A) a recipient of Medicaid during a pregnancy;
17	and
18	(B) using medical transportation program
19	services to travel to and from a covered health care service related
20	to the pregnancy, including postpartum care; and
21	(3) regardless of whether the child is also a
22	recipient of Medicaid.
23	(c) The executive commissioner may adopt rules to implement
24	this section.

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1 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act 2 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 3 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 4 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 5 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 6 waiver or authorization is granted.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
