A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the prevailing wage for work associated with public
- 3 work contracts; authorizing a penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2258.023, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a), (b), and (d) and adding Subsections (b-1)
- 7 and (f) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The contractor who is awarded a contract by a public
- 9 body or a subcontractor of the contractor:
- 10 (1) shall pay not less than the rates determined under
- 11 Section 2258.022 to a worker employed by it in the execution of the
- 12 contract; and
- 13 (2) may not improperly classify a worker employed by
- 14 it in the execution of the contract as an independent contractor in
- 15 order to avoid paying the worker under Subdivision (1).
- 16 (b) A contractor or subcontractor who violates this section
- 17 shall pay to the state or a political subdivision of the state on
- 18 whose behalf the contract is made $\frac{$90}{$}$ [$\frac{$60}{$}$] for:
- 19 <u>(1)</u> each worker employed for each calendar day or part
- 20 of the day that the worker is paid less than the wage rates
- 21 stipulated in the contract; or
- 22 (2) each worker misclassified as an independent
- 23 contractor for each calendar day or part of the day that the worker
- 24 is misclassified.

- 1 $\underline{\text{(b-1)}}$ A public body awarding a contract shall specify $\underline{\text{the}}$
- 2 [this] penalty provided for by Subsection (b) in the contract.
- 3 (d) The public body shall:
- 4 (1) audit a public work contract to ensure compliance
- 5 with this chapter:
- 6 (A) throughout the term of the contract; and
- 7 (B) not later than the 30th day before the date
- 8 the work is scheduled to be completed on the contract; and
- 9 $\underline{\text{(2)}}$ use any money collected under this section to
- 10 offset the costs incurred in the administration of this chapter.
- 11 (f) The payment requirement under Subsection (a)(1) may
- 12 only be satisfied by payment to the employee in the form of per diem
- 13 wages.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a public work contract entered into on or after the effective
- 16 date of this Act. A public work contract entered into before the
- 17 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 18 date the contract was entered into, and the former law is continued
- 19 in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
