- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 29, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 29.1544 to read as follows: 7
- Sec. 29.1544. REPORTING OF CERTAIN INFORMATION REGARDING 8 PREKINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS; AGENCY REPORT. (a) The agency by rule 9 shall require each school district that offers a prekindergarten 10 11 program under Section 29.153 and each private entity that provides 12 a prekindergarten program under contract with a school district to report the following information in the form and manner prescribed 13 14 by the agency for each prekindergarten class offered by the district or private entity: 15
- (1) the number of students in each prekindergarten 16
- 17 class;

- 18 (2) the number of certified teachers in each
- prekindergarten class; 19
- (3) the number of teacher's aides 20 in each
- 21 prekindergarten class;
- 22 (4) whether each prekindergarten class is full-day or
- 23 half-day; and
- 24 (5) if the district offers half-day classes, whether

- 1 the district offers two half-day classes per day.
- 2 (b) From the information submitted under Subsection (a),
- 3 the agency shall determine the total number of teachers and
- 4 teacher's aides in prekindergarten classes in this state.
- 5 (c) From the information submitted under Subsection (a) and
- 6 for purposes of calculating the student/teacher ratio for each
- 7 prekindergarten class offered by a school district or private
- 8 entity that provides a prekindergarten program under contract with
- 9 a school district, the agency shall count each teacher or teacher's
- 10 <u>aide:</u>
- 11 (1) once for a full-day class; and
- 12 (2) twice for a half-day class if the district offers
- 13 two half-day classes per day.
- 14 (d) Not later than August 1 of each year, the agency shall
- 15 prepare and submit a report to the legislature based on the
- 16 information collected under Subsection (a).
- 17 SECTION 2. Not later than August 1, 2020, the Texas
- 18 Education Agency shall submit the initial report required under
- 19 Section 29.1544, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
