- 9 HEALTH PROGRAMS. (a) In this section, "institution of higher
- 10 education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 11 (b) During the fall semester of each academic year, an
- 12 institution of higher education shall distribute by e-mail to each
- 13 student enrolled at the institution information regarding women's
- 14 health programs administered by the Health and Human Services
- 15 Commission, including information about:
- 16 (1) the eligibility requirements for those programs;
- 17 and
- 18 (2) the enrollment procedures for those programs,
- 19 including a link to the Health and Human Services Commission's
- 20 Internet website that hosts that enrollment information.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 51.9196, Education Code, as added by
- 22 this Act, applies beginning with the 2019 fall semester.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
