H.B. No. 60

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a requirement that public institutions of higher
3 education provide certain information regarding certain women's
4 health programs to students.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
7 amended by adding Section 51.9196 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 51.9196. REQUIRED INFORMATION REGARDING WOMEN'S
9 HEALTH PROGRAMS. (a) In this section, "institution of higher
10 education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.

11 (b) During the fall semester of each academic year, an
12 institution of higher education shall distribute by e-mail to each
13 student enrolled at the institution information regarding women's
14 health programs administered by the Health and Human Services
15 Commission, including information about:

16 (1) the eligibility requirements for those programs;
17 and

18 (2) the enrollment procedures for those programs,
19 including a link to the Health and Human Services Commission's
20 Internet website that hosts that enrollment information.

21 SECTION 2. Section 51.9196, Education Code, as added by
22 this Act, applies beginning with the 2019 fall semester.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
