## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 6 SECTION 1. This Act shall be cited as the Honorable Ruth
- 7 Jones McClendon Act.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 481.125, Health and Safety Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 10 (g) It is an exception to the application of Subsections (a)
- 11 and (b) that the person is an employee, volunteer, duly authorized
- 12 agent, or participant in, or is otherwise involved in operating, a
- 13 pilot program established under other law to prevent the spread of
- 14 certain infectious and communicable diseases.
- 15 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 19 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the
- 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 22 before the effective date.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
