3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 662.071 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 662.071. MILITARY SPOUSE APPRECIATION DAY. (a) May 8
7	is Military Spouse Appreciation Day to recognize the role of the
8	husbands and wives of the brave individuals who serve in the United
9	States armed forces or state military forces. This day
10	commemorates:
11	(1) the sacrifices military spouses make during the
12	weeks, months, and years a loved one is away from home protecting
13	our freedom; and
14	(2) the vital support military spouses provide to
15	veterans returning home from military service.
16	(b) Military Spouse Appreciation Day shall be regularly
17	observed by appropriate programs and activities coordinated by the
18	Texas Veterans Commission.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23	Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
