- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 2.101 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 2.101. MAGISTRATE'S NAME ON SIGNED ORDER. Any signed
- 8 order that is issued by a magistrate under this code or any signed
- 9 order pertaining to a criminal matter that is issued by a magistrate
- 10 under the Family Code, the Government Code, or other law of this
- 11 state must include, with the magistrate's signature, the
- 12 magistrate's name in legible handwriting, legible typewritten
- 13 form, or legible stamp print.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act in adding
- 15 Article 2.101, Code of Criminal Procedure, applies to a signed
- 16 order issued by a magistrate on or after the effective date of this
- 17 Act. A signed order issued by a magistrate before the effective
- 18 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 19 order was issued, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 20 purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
