- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 33A, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 33A.051 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33A.051. FALSE CALLER IDENTIFICATION INFORMATION
- 8 DISPLAY. (a) A person commits an offense if the person, with the
- 9 intent to defraud, harass, or cause harm, makes a call or engages in
- 10 any other conduct using any type of technology that results in the
- 11 display on another person's telecommunications device of data that
- 12 <u>misrepresents the actor's identity or telephone number.</u>
- 13 (b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 14 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a
- 15 conviction for an offense under this section may not be used for
- 16 enhancement purposes under any other section of this chapter.
- 17 (d) It is a defense to prosecution that the actor:
- 18 (1) blocked caller identification information;
- 19 (2) was a peace officer or federal law enforcement
- 20 officer lawfully discharging an official duty;
- 21 (3) was an officer, agent, or employee of a federal
- 22 intelligence or security agency lawfully discharging an official
- 23 duty;
- 24 <u>(4) was an officer, agent, or employee of a</u>

- 1 telecommunications service provider who was:
- 2 (A) acting in the provider's capacity as an
- 3 intermediary for the transmission of telephone service, a Voice
- 4 over Internet Protocol transmission, or another type of
- 5 telecommunications transmission between the caller and the
- 6 recipient;
- 7 (B) providing or configuring a service or service
- 8 feature as requested by a customer;
- 9 (C) acting in a manner that is authorized or
- 10 required by other law; or
- 11 (D) engaging in other conduct that is a necessary
- 12 incident to the provision of service; or
- 13 (5) was a private investigator licensed under Chapter
- 14 1702, Occupations Code, lawfully conducting an investigation.
- (e) For the purposes of this section, "telecommunications
- 16 service provider" means a:
- 17 (1) telecommunications provider, as defined by
- 18 Section 51.002, Utilities Code; or
- 19 (2) provider of telecommunications service, advanced
- 20 communications services, or information service, as those terms are
- 21 defined by 47 U.S.C. Section 153.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
