13	service, that results in the display on another person's
14	telecommunications device of data that misrepresents the actor's
15	identity or telephone number.
16	(b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
17	(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a
18	conviction for an offense under this section may not be used for
19	enhancement purposes under any other section of this chapter.
