## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the inclusion of information about oversize and 3 overweight vehicles in the curriculum of driver education and 4 driving safety courses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1001, Education Code, is

amended by adding Section 1001.1092 to read as follows:

8 <u>Sec. 1001.1092. INFORMATION RELATING TO OVERSIZE AND</u> 9 <u>OVERWEIGHT VEHICLES. The commission by rule shall require that</u> 10 <u>information relating to methods of safely operating a motor vehicle</u> 11 <u>near an oversize or overweight vehicle, including safe following</u> 12 <u>distances and safe passing methods, be included in the curriculum</u> 13 <u>of each driver education course and driving safety course.</u>

14 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than March 1, 2020, the Texas 15 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules 16 required by Section 1001.1092, Education Code, as added by this 17 Act.

(b) Not later than September 1, 2020, each provider of a driver education course or driving safety course shall submit the curriculum adopted pursuant to Section 1001.1092, Education Code, as added by this Act, to the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation for approval.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
