- 12 <u>distances and safe passing methods</u>, be included in the curriculum
- 13 of each driver education course and driving safety course.
- SECTION 2. (a) Not later than March 1, 2020, the Texas
- 15 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules
- 16 required by Section 1001.1092, Education Code, as added by this
- 17 Act.
- 18 (b) Not later than September 1, 2020, each provider of a
- 19 driver education course or driving safety course shall submit the
- 20 curriculum adopted pursuant to Section 1001.1092, Education Code,
- 21 as added by this Act, to the Texas Commission of Licensing and
- 22 Regulation for approval.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
