 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the inclusion of information about oversize and
 1-20 overweight vehicles in the curriculum of driver education and
 1-21 driving safety courses.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1001, Education Code, is
 1-24 amended by adding Section 1001.1092 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 1001.1092. INFORMATION RELATING TO OVERSIZE AND
 1-26 OVERWEIGHT VEHICLES. The commission by rule shall require that
 1-27 information relating to methods of safely operating a motor vehicle
 1-28 near an oversize or overweight vehicle, including safe following
 1-29 distances and safe passing methods, be included in the curriculum
 1-30 of each driver education course and driving safety course.

1-31 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than March 1, 2020, the Texas
 1-32 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules
 1-33 required by Section 1001.1092, Education Code, as added by this
 1-34 Act.

1-35 (b) Not later than September 1, 2020, each provider of a
 1-36 driver education course or driving safety course shall submit the
 1-37 curriculum adopted pursuant to Section 1001.1092, Education Code,
 1-38 as added by this Act, to the Texas Commission of Licensing and
 1-39 Regulation for approval.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
